Topic summary: Christopher Columbus was an Italian sailor and <u>explorer</u> who discovered a way to sail from Spain to Europe to the Americas. Columbus was trying to find India and China which is why he named the Islands he arrived at the West Indies. The arrival of his ships brought European culture and beliefs to this ‘New World’, which was changed forever. Many European countries and their sailors found great wealth in these lands. However, the <u>civilisations</u> that had existed in the Americas for <u>centuries</u> , before Columbus arrived, were almost completely destroyed by war, <u>disease</u> and slavery.
