Topic summary: Transport (or transportation) is the movement of people or things from one location to another. Within large cities, people need transport to take them from one place to another and goods need to be delivered to businesses. There are several different types of transport, each of which has its advantages and disadvantages. Two of the main problems with transport in cities are that it causes congestion and pollution and therefore needs to be managed.
